



## DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

### RATIONALE:

- Students in Western Australian schools are required to be clean and appropriately dressed for school activities.

### GUIDELINES:

- School uniforms are readily available and supplied by Uniform concepts 832/834 Beaufort St Inglewood, 9270 4658.

School uniforms are encouraged for the following reasons –

- cost effectiveness
- availability
- gives a sense of identity – helps school spirit
- reduced competition and not subject to fashion demands
- reduces peer group pressure
- presents well
- children are easily identified

### School Uniform:

- Hats: Bucket style hat, or legionnaire or broad brimmed hat. (Charcoal with reversible faction colour i.e. red, gold, royal or maroon.) No brand name logos.
- School Polo – charcoal, jade green and white
- Shorts – charcoal
- Skirt with inbuilt shorts – charcoal
- Dress - charcoal, jade green and white check
- Pants – charcoal
- Jacket - charcoal, jade green and white
- Leggings – charcoal and white
- Hijabs – charcoal, jade green and white

***The Campus Dress Code Policy has been endorsed by the School Council and Board***

### Additional Information:

- The stipulated uniform should be worn to school and on all excursions (Special Days excepted)
- Exceptions may be made on medical or religious grounds.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn e.g. closed in shoes, runners or sandals.
- During all sporting activities appropriate clothing should be worn.
- The only jewellery worn should be that which is no danger to the child or other children through incidental contact e.g. earrings should be studs or sleepers rather than loops and dangling styles.
- All temporary tattoos, nail polish and make-up should be removed for school days.
- All shoulder length hair should be tied up with appropriate hair ties.
- For children continually out of uniform, a pro-forma (attached) should be sent to parents.
- Notes regarding excursions should state uniforms as a requirement: no uniform – no excursion.
- All clothing should be clearly labelled with the student's name with permanent marker.
- Parents should be informed of the school dress code at the time of enrolment – acceptance of enrolment would assume acceptance of dress code.
- Children will not be permitted to play in open areas without a suitable sunsmart hat.
- Children will wear sunsmart hats during sport and physical education conducted away from cover. The “no hat, no play” policy will be enforced all year round.
- A reminder – no denim, no brand names/logos.
- Students are reminded that denim, brand names logos are not acceptable.

### SANCTIONS:

- Students need to be in Campus uniform to go to the oval.
- A note is to be sent home to parents for students not in uniform
